

## Did you miss out on the on-site Health Screening? There is another option!



### Wellness Qualifications - Incentive to Participate

Completing all three wellness qualifications is beneficial no matter which health plan you choose.

If you complete the three wellness qualifications by March 31, 2018:

You will qualify for the Low Deductible Health Plan in FY19\*

OR

You will earn the maximum State contribution for your Health Savings Account (HSA), if you choose the High Deductible Health Plan for FY19.\*; (\$500 single coverage, \$1,000 family coverage).

\*If your spouse is on your health plan, both you and your covered spouse must complete the three qualifications to be eligible for the Low Deductible Health Plan or maximum State HSA contribution if you choose the High Deductible Health Plan.

Note: Employees hired or spouses added to the plan after July 1, 2017 and Opt Outs do not need to complete these qualifications during FY18, to be eligible for the Low Deductible Health Plan for FY19 or the maximum State HSA contribution, if you choose the High Deductible Health Plan for FY19.

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Members who missed the on-site health screening opportunities can still meet the screening qualification by going to their health care provider.

Members receive one annual wellness preventive exam covered by the health plan each plan year. The cost of the screening tests will only be covered if it is part of an annual wellness preventive exam. Employees that have opted out of the state insurance are not eligible.

Please note: In many clinics, it will take over 30 days to get on the schedule for an annual wellness preventive exam. Plan ahead and make your appointment early, so you can submit the form and receive your confirmation notice prior to the deadline.

The **Health Care Provider Form** can be found at [benefit.staywell.com](http://benefit.staywell.com). The health care provider must fill in the test results and sign the form. Submit form by fax, mail, or secure upload following instructions on the form.

If a member has already had screening tests taken by their provider since April 1, 2017, the form can be completed by the health care provider using data from screening tests conducted during that visit. Not all data pieces are required.

**The cost of the lab tests will only be covered if it is included as part of an annual preventive wellness exam.** For example: If a member makes an appointment only to do the lab tests, the cost will not be covered by the health plan. If a member requests screening tests at any other type of appointment that is not an annual wellness preventive exam, the costs will not be covered by the health plans.
